On a **home computer** navigate to OverDrive by visiting the library home page at <http://www.hegganlibrary.org> and clicking “Borrow eBooks and more with OverDrive”

You should be on a web page that says “South Jersey Audiobook and eBook Download Center”. First you will need a program called **Adobe Digital Editions**, you can find it by clicking on “Help” at the top of the screen and then on “Applications.” Click “Adobe Digital Editions” on the following page.

Follow the instructions to **download Adobe Digital Editions** and create (or log into an existing) **Adobe Id**. When you are done return to OverDrive.

Log in by clicking “Sign In” in the upper right corner of the web site. Select the “Margaret E. Heggan Library” and enter your full library card number (no spaces). You should be brought back to the main page, and you’ll know if you’re signed in if the upper right corner of the site says “Sign Out.”

To find an eBook use either the “Quick Search” feature or “Advanced Search” by following the link under the quick search bar. Click “Search”.

When you find a book you want to borrow hover your mouse over it and click the “Borrow” button.

If all of our digital copies are checked out: You will be able to sign up for a waiting list for the next available copy, and OverDrive will notify you via e-mail.

If a copy is available: You will be redirected to your Bookshelf page, click the “Download” button next to the book and select the file type you’ll want. Click “Confirm and Download.”

This will prompt a download of the item. If prompted with the option select “Open”, not “Save As”. If not, locate the file on your computer and open it with Adobe Digital Editions.

The book will open in Adobe Digital Editions. Connect your Nook to your computer using a USB cable (your Nook power cable doubles as one) and you’ll see a new icon in Adobe Digital Editions in your book shelf for your Nook. Drag and drop your eBook onto the icon and it will transfer.

You should find your eBook in the “My Documents” folder in your Nook.
