The committee is made up of members of the Association for Library Service to Children (ALSC), a division of the American Library Association. New sites are added three times a year. All sites are reviewed twice a year to guarantee they are still relevant, appropriate and accessible.

The Car Book (2012 & 2013)

REF AUTO 629.222029 GILLIS

Looks at safety, fuel economy, and standard features. Also rates repair costs, warranties, vehicle complaints, preventive maintenance, and insurance costs.

Fuel Economy Guide (1992-2013)

REF AUTO 629.28 FUEL

Published by the U.S. Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy. Provides the MPG for city and highway driving and annual fuel cost.

The New Car Cost Guide (2013)

REF AUTO 629.222029 NEW

Covers factory options, standard equipment and accessories, tire styles and prices, and manufacturer's codes for over 250 cars. The dealer invoice and suggested retail prices are also listed.

Consumer Reports (2008-2013) and Buying Guide (2012 & 2013)

The April issue is dedicated to cars. The library has the current year available for check out. We also maintain a reference set going back to 2008.

Consumer Reports (1991-present) and Buying Guide (1999 to present)

The magazine and buying guide are also available in the MasterFile Elite database, which is available to library cardholders.

Kelley Blue Book (1998-2012)

REF DESK 629.222029 BLU

Provides the list, trade-in, and retail prices for used cars and trucks. It also has the price for private sales.

NADA Official Used Car Guide (2006-2014) and NADA Official Older Car Guide (1994-2005)

REF DESK 629.222029 NADA

Provides retail and trade-in prices.

NADA Classic, Collectible, Exotic and Muscle Car Guide and Directory

REF DESK 629.2 NADA

Provides a value range for cars and trucks (1926-1993) and exotic cars (1946-2013).
