


## New Year . . . New Career

much more are available, along with many computer skills tutorials.

Job & Career Accelerator, a component of Learning Express Library, can help you create professional resumes and cover letters, find available jobs, explore over 1,000 occupations, and much more.

Learning a second language may also be beneficial in today's job market. *Mango Languages*, a simple, interactive language program which offers 62 foreign language and 16 ESL courses, is available to library cardholders through the library website on home computers or mobile devices.
