Listen to a classic, best seller, or biography this summer.



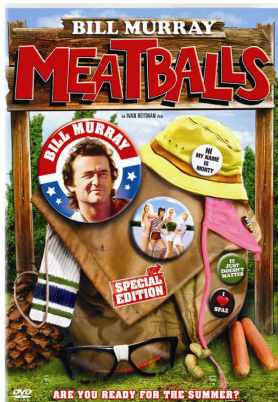
