The library is offering its patrons some select services during the COVID-19 closure.

The library is offering a contactless curbside service to Heggan Library cardholders.



Patrons can simply go to the library's website, www.hegganlibrary.org, for information, and to place holds on books and other library materials. When the materials are ready, a library staff member will call to set up a time and offer instructions for how to pick up these materials.



Use of library computers is available to Heggan Library cardholders by appointment. Simply call the library, 856-589-3334, to schedule a time to come in.

Museums Reopening

Museums have begun opening, and the library is pleased to announce that we have begun offering the library's museum passes to cardholders again.

As of July 23, passes for the American Swedish Museum, the Battleship NJ, Gloucester County Historical Society Museum, Independence Seaport Museum, Museum of American History at Deptford, Philadelphia Magic Gardens, and Woodford Cedar Run Wildlife Refuge are available. The library also has a parking pass for New Jersey State Parks.

Many museums require that you reserve a time in advance online. All require masks and distancing. Some areas may not be accessible.

Passes for other museums will be available when the museums open and begin accepting library membership passes.

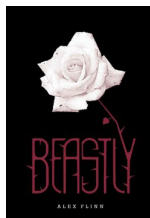

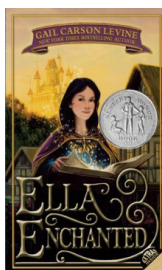
