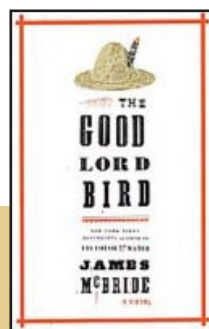

Each year, the National Book Foundation presents awards to winners in Fiction, Non-fiction, Poetry, and Young People’s Literature.

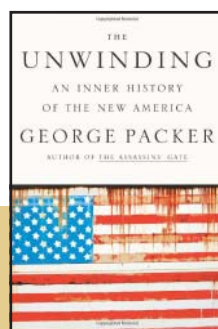
