The winner of the challenge will receive a \$50.00 gift card to Barnes and Noble. Open to Heggan Cardholders only.

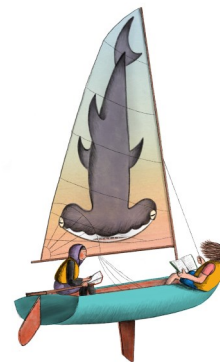


SUMMER BINGO!

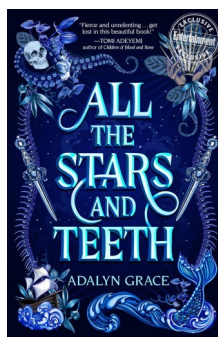
