BOOK REVIEWS

Off Planet

Maite Martinez lives a somewhat normal life, if you call being an undercover alien fugitive normal. She has a best friend, a mother who loves her, and a job at a diner. When she defends herself against a rude customer, her life quickly changes. Maite is caught by law enforcement (overseen by the evil SpaceTech) and is punished with an almost impossible job working on the surface of a lava planet. Can she survive her sentence, or will the government be down one less enemy?

Aileen Erin is by far my favorite author and this is the first book in her newest series, *The Aunare Chronicles*. At first, reading this felt like cheating on my favorite book by Ms. Erin, *Becoming Alpha*, because this book is just that good. I couldn't stop reading!!! In the middle, though, it got a bit slow and it felt like the same thing happened over and over as we watch Maite being pushed to her limits. Luckily action picks up in the end and leaves readers dying to know what will happen next!

Many of the characters are funny and endearing. One character named **Lorne** is totally swoonworthy. Some of the best parts of this book were the interactions between **Maite** and **Lorne** and between **Maite** and **Roan**. One of **Aileen Erin's** best qualities is her ability to write characters. There's never a character you won't like and especially no book by her that could disappoint!

Off Balance

Like *Off Planet*, *Off Balance* (Book 2 in the *Aunare Chronicles* series)

will pull you in from the first page. Wow! How often is the second book in a series a letdown after a fantastic first? That is NOT the case here.

Amihanna (no longer called Maite, her Earth name) has been returned to her home planet to heal from her run-ins with SpaceTech and begin to understand her heritage, but even here she still feels like an alien. Being half human, half Aunare on Earth was awful, but here on the planet of her father there is a not so covert hatred of "halfers."

Amihanna does not know who can be trusted. On top of everything else, as the betrothed of Lorne, destined to become the high queen of the Aunare, she becomes an even greater target for those who already despise her. She has horrid nightmares from which she awakes screaming. Self preservation kicks in and Amihanna considers fleeing the planet.

Amihanna does not want the political worries. She does not know how she feels about Lorne. She does not want to be queen. She does not want people to look at her like they want to kill her where she stands. Amihanna does want to sleep without nightmares. She wants to be with her family and get to know her father. She wants a future without fighting just to live.

No matter how much she wants to go away, **Amihanna** is constantly drawn back to **Lorne**. He makes her nightmares go away. He knows when she's had enough stress. He knows when she's about to lose it. He starts getting to her and she's petrified of trusting in him.

Can **Amihanna** ever find peace? Will the long reach of **Earth's SpaceTech** bullies destroy her forever? Is there room anywhere for a half **Aunare** half human? Read it and find out.

Aileen Erin's Cipher

Cipher is the ultimate computer hacker and gamer. She is not just a computer genius; she has "powers" that others want to contain. She was born with a red helix, which means her powers are unstable. Since the deaths of her parents, Cipher has spent her life running. Never setting down any permanent roots, she has been keeping her identity secret. The risk of being caught by the wrong people could mean she becomes someone's science experiment.

Cipher avoids friendships to keep others safe – from herself as well as from those who might use them to get to her – as she tries to solve the mystery of her power.

She had a friend once, but that was long ago and before she went on the

run with her parents. **Knight** has had a

difficult life. Saved from the father who tried to kill him as a boy by Emma, he has done everything he can to

never be abused again. Now a man, **Knight** is easy on the eyes and brilliant. He becomes a double agent taking an undercover position "working" for the evil men tracking **Cipher** and other red helix "mutants" like her. But, **Knight** has other plans. Can **Cipher** trust him? Does he really want to help her? What's his secret agenda?

This is a fast paced action packed story with altering view points between **Cipher** and **Knight**. The insight **Aileen Erin** gives her readers into the minds of these characters helps us to fully understand the magnitude of their situations. **Cipher** is the first book in the **Shadow Ravens** series. It will keep you on the edge of your seat as you race to the end of this story!
