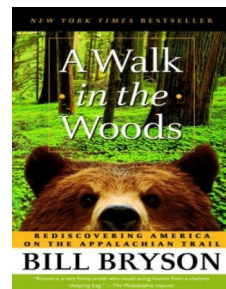

DIRECTOR'S CORNER

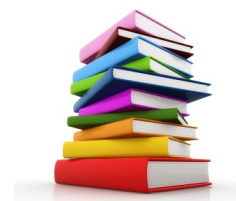

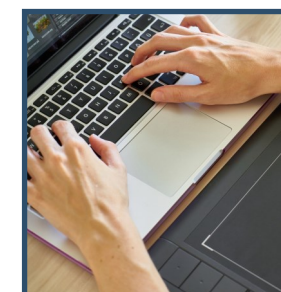
How can you participate? Read a good book! Come to the library and check out as many books as you need to celebrate all month long!

Monday, May 16 at 6:30 pm



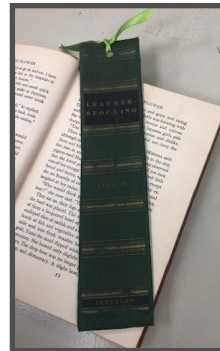
