## Ancient Language Courses Now Available

Have you ever wanted to experience the Homer's Odyssey in its original Ancient Greek or the Old Testament in Biblical Hebrew? It may sound far-fetched, but the library now offers introductory online courses in these and other languages for free through Mango Languages!

Mango's new Religious & Scholarly Course Collection includes Scholarly Latin, Ancient Greek, Koine Greek (the language of the New Testament) as well as Biblical Hebrew.



These online courses are accessible from your home or on your mobile device. Each one offers a rich visual and sensory learning experience that integrates classical texts with the latest language techniques and rich cultural notes.

Mango Languages offers 62 different language courses and 16 ESL courses, and is accessible to library cardholders on home computers or mobile devices. It uses voice recognition software, so a microphone is required.

## Red Cross Holiday Cards for Heroes

- Use generic salutations such as "Dear Service Member." Cards addressed to specific individuals can not be delivered through this program.
- Only cards are being accepted. Do not send or include letters.
- Do not include email or home addresses on the cards. The program is not meant to foster pen-pal relationships.
- Do not include inserts of any kind, including photos, these items will be removed during the reviewing process.
- Please refrain from choosing cards with glitter or using loose glitter as it can aggravate health issues of ill and injured warriors.

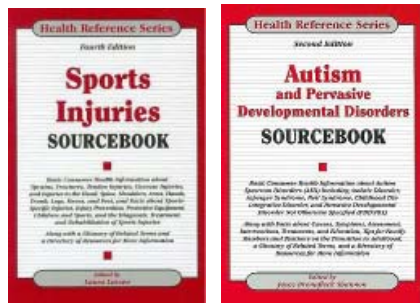
