October 18 was Library Snapshot Day, a day for capturing the impact the New Jersey libraries have on their communities.

On October 18, 2016 . . .

- 424 people visited the library
- 28 people attended adult events
- 52 patrons attended children's events
- 4 new library cards were issued
- 523 books, movies, and other materials were checked out
- 92 reference questions were answered
- 81 people used the computers
