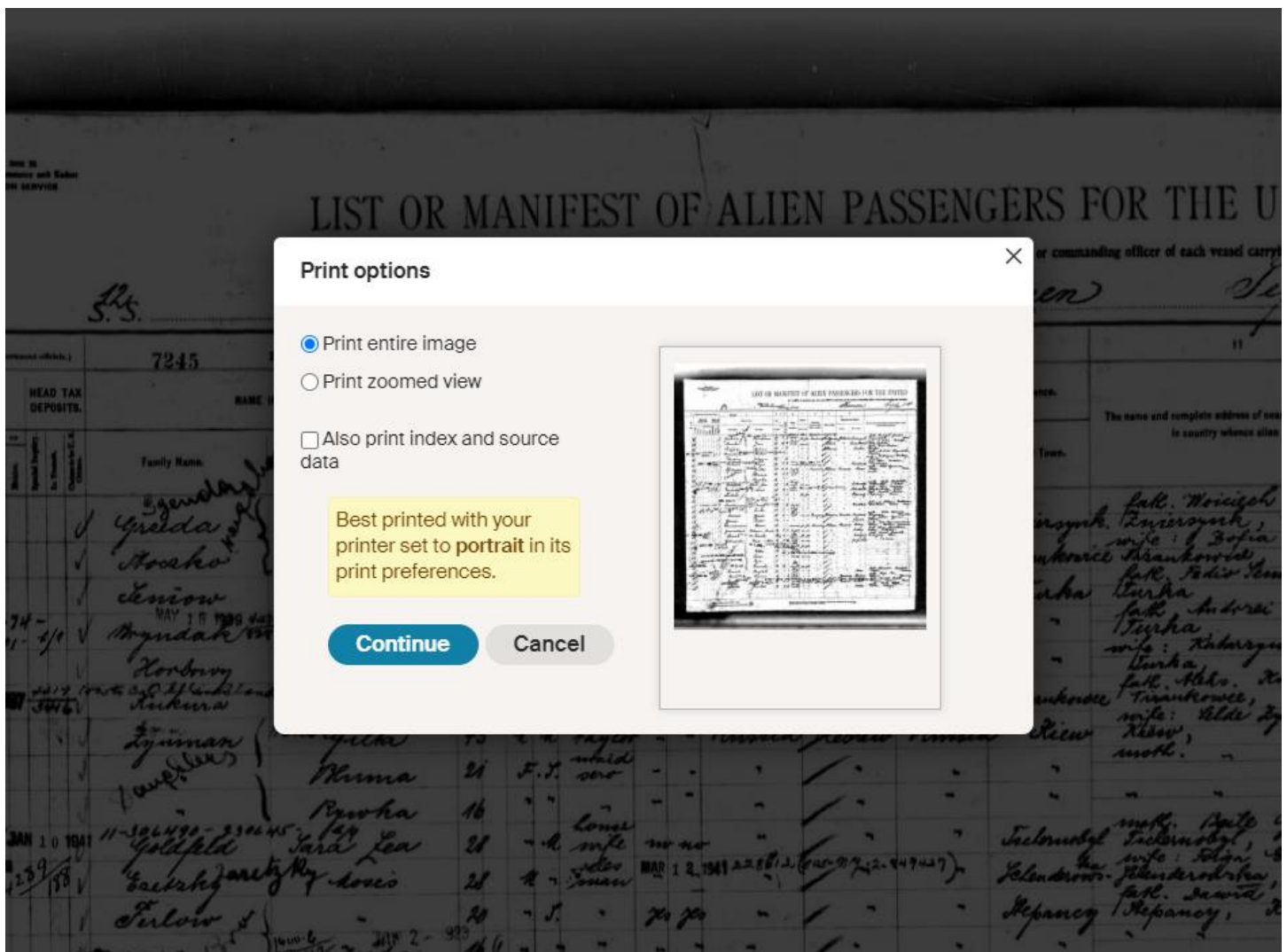

10. Click the wrench icon of the right side of the screen. Click **Print** to print the document.



11. The **default** print option is **Print entire image**. This will obviously print the entire list.
12. If you zoomed into the section of the list that has your relative's name you can print that larger image. Select **Print Zoomed View**.
13. Click **Continue**.
14. The **Print Window** will open. You can print your image from that window.
15. Click **Print**. You will get another window that will give you the **price of the copy**. Click **OK**.
16. There will be another **window** that pops up. Click **OK**.
17. You will retrieve the **item** at the **print release station**. You can ask for **assistance** from the **reference librarian**.
